PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioner/A3, prays for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Clause 6(2) (3)(4) of TNSC (RDCS) Order 1982 r/w 7(1)(a)(ii) of Essential Commodities Act, 1955, in Crime No.220 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the respondent police seized 6 bags of PDS rice (each contains 50 kgs).

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner's name has not been mentioned in FIR.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that property and vehicle were seized.

5. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioner can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial

Magistrate III, Madurai, within 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of the order,

(i) the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the likesum to their satisfaction;

(ii) the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders.
