PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

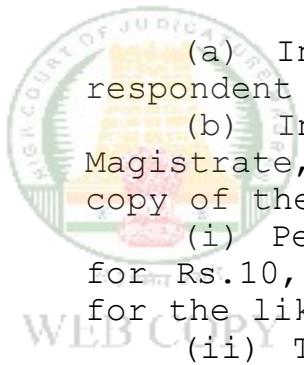
Petitioner, who is arrayed as accused pray for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for offence punishable under Section 25(1)(b) of Indian Arms Act, 1984, in Crime No.269/2016 on the file of respondent police.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 24.09.2016 the respondent police conducted the vehicle check up and found that the petitioner and one Devaraj came into a two wheeler and they were intercepted by the police, the petitioner absconded and while enquiry the said Devaraj found that one barrel gun was in a broken condition kept inside a gunny bag along with one Axa blade and a rod which is used to insert the gun powder.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submit that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submits that there are two accused involved in this case and the petitioner is A2 and A1 already arrested and he is in prison and the investigation is going on.

5. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioner can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;



(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thuraiyur, within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of the order,

(i) Petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to their satisfaction;

(ii) The petitioner shall be available for interrogation by the respondent police once in a week i.e. on every Monday at 10.00 a.m until further orders.
