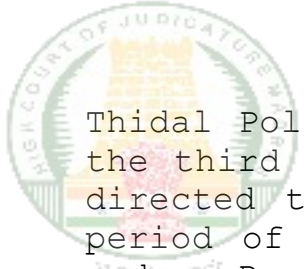
ORDER

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side)on instructions, would submit that the complaint preferred by the petitioner is pending before the Inspector of Police (Crime), Thilakar Thidal Police Station, Madurai District.

4.In view of the above submission made by the learned Government Advocate, the Inspector of Police (Crime), Thilakar



Thidal Police Station, Madurai District, is *suo motu* impleaded as the third respondent in this petition and the third respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and complete the same within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the third respondent police shall take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]**. In case of closure of the complaint, a copy of the closure report be furnished to the petitioner within a week of such closure. On receipt of the same, it is open to the petitioner to take action in accordance with law.

5.This Criminal Original Petition is disposed of accordingly.
