During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent police shall take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]. In case of closure of the complaint, a copy of the closure report be furnished to the petitioner in a week of such closure. On receipt of the same, it is open to the petitioner to take action in accordance with law.
