ORDER

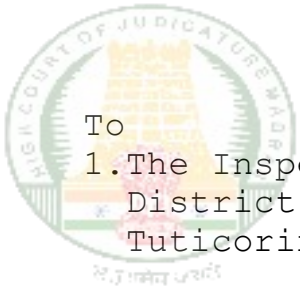
It is an application seeking a direction to the respondent police to file a final report in Crime No.62 of 2014 within a time frame.
