On a reading of the complaint dated 16.11.2015, this Court finds that there is a boundary dispute between the petitioner and the opposite party, inasmuch as both of them have purchased the properties adjacent to each other from the Society. Under such circumstances, the police cannot be directed to conduct the investigation in an issue of this nature. Hence, this Criminal Original Petition is closed with
