O R D E R

This petition has been filed, seeking to direct the learned II Additional District and Sessions Court-cum-PCR Court, Tirunelveli, to accept the surrender of the petitioner/Accused No.7 and consider the petitioner's bail on the same day of his surrender in connection with the case in Crime No.286 of 2016 pending on the file of the respondent police.

2.The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated for the alleged offences under Sections 341, 294(b), 506(ii) IPC @ 147, 341, 294 (b), 506(ii) IPC r/w Section 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(Va) of SC/ST (POA) Act 2015, in Crime No.286 of 2016 and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the SC & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, the petitioner cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioner has come forward with the present petition for the said prayer.

3.Heard Mr.A.P.Balasubramanian, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), who takes notice for the respondent.

4.Considering the submissions of both sides, this criminal original petition is disposed of with the following direction:-

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned II Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-PCR
