PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

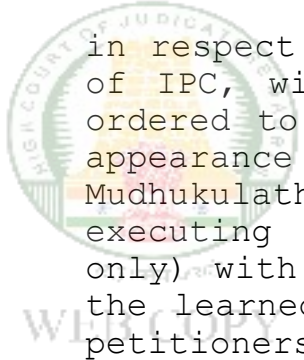
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused Nos.3 to 5 in Crime No.279 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(i) of IPC and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the learned counsel for the intervenor and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) for the respondent/State.

3.The learned Government Advocate (crl. Side) states that totally there are five accused in this case. The petitioners herein are accused Nos.2 to 5 respectively. The co-accused Nos.1 and 2 were granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.23411 of 2016, dated 15.12.2016. He would further states that Sections were altered into 294(b), 323 and 506(i) of IPC.

4.Considering the above facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners



in respect of altered charges under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(i) of IPC, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court, Mudhukulathur, Ramanathapuram District, and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of four weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

5.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
