PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

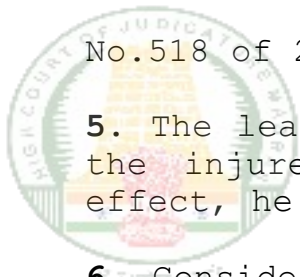
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as accused Nos.1 to 3 & 5 to 7, in Crime No.517 of 2016, on the file of the respondent police, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 352, 323, 324 & 506(i) I.P.C., and hence, seek anticipatory bail.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent / State.

3. The case of the prosecution is that on 11.12.2016, at about 09.00 p.m., the petitioners attacked the *de facto* complainant and his family members, abused them in filthy language and threatened them with dire consequences.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that this is a case and counter and the counter case has been registered in Crime



No.518 of 2016.

5. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the injured has been discharged from the Hospital and to that effect, he has produced a copy of the discharge summary.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners, with certain conditions. Accordingly, they are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Kodaikanal, and on each of them executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that the petitioners 2 to 6 shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of four weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation and the first petitioner shall appear before the respondent police on every Monday at 10.30 a.m., for a period of four weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
