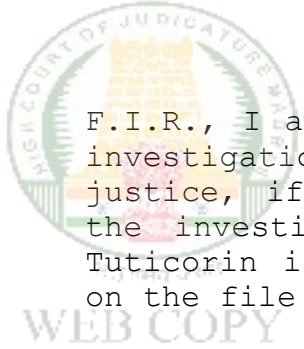
2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) appearing for the State.
