O R D E R

3. It is represented by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) that, on the complaint lodged by one Jeyakumar, against the petitioner herein, petition enquiry is pending.

4. The petitioner is directed to participate in the enquiry and during enquiry, he shall not be harassed. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent Police is free to register an FIR and this order shall not be a bar to the petitioner against arrest.
