3. On reading of the complaint, dated 11.01.2016, it is seen that there is a wordy quarrel between the petitioner and the children of her husband's first wife. Under such circumstances, no positive direction can be given to the respondent Police to register a case. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to work out her remedy in the manner known to law.
