PRAYER: This petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., to direct the respondents to register the complaint forthwith petitioner written complaint to the first respondent on 01.02.2016 and to the second respondent on 27.07.2015 against the accused persons under Sections 120 (b), 193, 294(b), 307, 324, 497, 498(A) and 506(ii) of the Indian Penal Code and provisions contemplated in Dowry Prohibition Act and Women Harassment Act.

O R D E R

The petitioner has filed this criminal original petition, under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking direction upon the second respondent to register a case, based on her complaint, dated 27.07.2015.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondents.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) has submitted that on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner, petition enquiry is pending.

4. In view of the above submission, the second respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and complete the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent Police shall take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others, reported in [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]. In case of closure of the complaint, a copy of the closure report be furnished to the petitioner within a week of such closure. On receipt of the same, it is open to the petitioner to work out her remedy in the manner known to law.



5. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
