3. Heard the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondents.

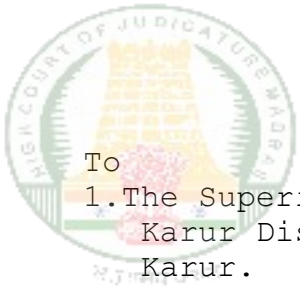
