PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehended arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the alleged offence punishable under Section 420 I.P.C., in Crime No.Not Known of 2016, on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. Heard Mr.M.S.Suresh Kumar, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.A.P.Balasubramani, learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the State.

It is seen that on 26.02.2016 when the matter came up for hearing, it was represented by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) that petition enquiry was pending and hence this Court granted interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner on condition that he should report before the respondent Police daily at 06.30 p.m..

4. Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) has submitted that the complaint lodged by the *de facto* complainant has been closed after conducting enquiry.

5. In view of the submission of the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), this criminal original petition is closed.
