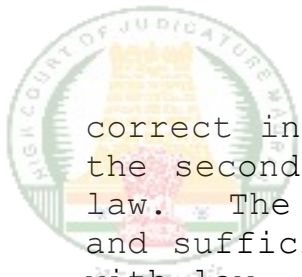

It is clearly stated in the petition that the petitioner has preferred a private complaint on 11.04.2015 before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Alangudi and thereafter a case has been registered by the second respondent in Crime No.96 of 2015 for the offences under Sections 147, 427, 294(b), 506(i) I.P.C. and 3(i) of PPD Act. Further it is also stated that the second respondent has not taken any action as contemplated under law. Furthermore, it is also stated that the petitioner has also submitted a representation by registered post on 03.02.2016 to the first respondent.
