ORDER

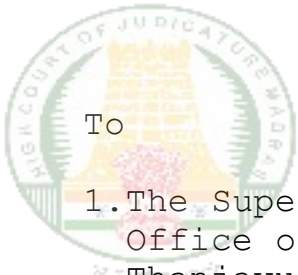
It is an application seeking a direction to the second respondent not to harass the petitioners in the name of enquiry.
