ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

3. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) has submitted that the respondent Police, after conducting enquiry, has registered a regular case, in Crime No.6 of 2016, on the complaint lodged by the *de facto* complainant.

4. In view of the submission of the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), this criminal original petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh anticipatory bail application by giving the Crime No.6 of 2016.
