The Petitioner has filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents herein to return the Fixed Deposit amount in Account No.0919401003627 and Jewels in Gold Loan Account No.0919842052840 in the 2nd respondent bank, within a stipulated period.

According to the petitioner, the petitioner's husband one late.Abuthalif during his lifetime, had deposited a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- in a Fixed Deposit Account in the second respondent bank and also pledged jewels and borrowed a sum of Rs.1,70,000/- for family expenses and he died on 18.04.2014 leaving the petitioner and his two children as legal heirs. Subsequently, the petitioner paid the entire jewel loan amount. Now, the petitioner filed an application before the second respondent to
