PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehended arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 417, 376 I.P.C., in Crime No. Not Known of 2016, on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. Heard Mr.J.K.Jeyaselan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.A.P.Balasubramani, learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the State.

3. Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) has submitted that the respondent Police, after conducting enquiry, has registered a regular case, in Crime No.5 of 2016, on the complaint lodged by the *de facto* complainant, under Sections 294(b), 417, 376 and 506(ii) I.P.C.

4. In view of the submission of the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), this criminal original petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh anticipatory bail application by giving the Crime No.5 of 2016.
