PRAYER: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of Mandamus directing the 2nd respondent to issue the Community Certificate to the petitioner's sons Manibharathi and Nateshkumar as 'Hindu Kuravan' Scheduled Caste Community in accordance with law at once on the basis of the petitioner's representation dated 05.07.2014.

Heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, as well as the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the respondents.

2.This writ petition has been filed for issuance of writ of Mandamus directing the second respondent, Tahsildar, to issue Community Certificates to the petitioner's sons one Manibharathi and Nateshkumar as 'Hindu Kuravan' Scheduled Caste Community in accordance with law at once on the basis of the petitioner's representation dated 05.07.2014.

3.The petitioner relied upon the certificate issued to the petitioner's sister stating that she belongs to 'Hindu Kuravan Community'. He has also relied upon the Community Certificate issued to the petitioner's sons stating that they belong to 'Hindu Kuravan Community'.



4.Considering the nature of the relief, we feel that Mandamus cannot be issued, however, we are inclined to give a direction to the second respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 29.09.2015, in accordance with law and on the basis of the materials submitted by the petitioner along with Government Orders issued from time to time, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The petitioner is also directed to place relevant documents for considering his representation.

5. The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly. No costs.
