The petitioner has come up with this Public Interest Litigation, challenging the order of the first respondent in G.O.Ms.No.398, Revenue N.M.7 Department, dated 19.08.2010, and to forbear the respondents from effecting any construction or converting the water body for any other purpose in S.Kodikulam Lake in Survey No.57/1 in North Alagarkovil Road, Madurai.

2. Today, when the matter was taken up, Mr.M.Govindan, leaned Special Government Pleader, on instructions from the official respondents, submitted that the said proposal has been dropped and thus, there will be no construction made on the lake. The said statement is recorded.

3. The Writ Petition, thus, has become infructuous and the same, accordingly, is dismissed. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petitions are also dismissed.
