PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

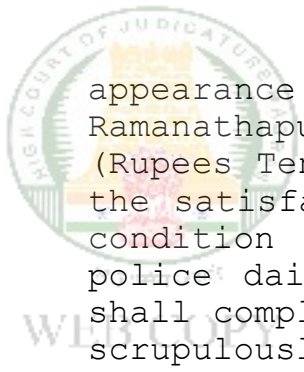
The petitioner, who is arrayed as accused, apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 323, 448, 427 and 506(ii) I.P.C., in Crime No.42 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 27.01.2016, the petitioner along with the other accused quarrelled with the de facto complainant and assaulted him and caused damage to his hotel to the tune of Rs.2,50,000/- as the quality of fried rice is not good. On complaint, case has been registered for the above said offences.

3.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence and prays for anticipatory bail in favour of the petitioner.

4.It is submitted by the learned Government Advocate (CrI.Side) that the de facto complainant sustained only simple injury.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the de facto complainant sustained only simple injury, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his



appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Ramanathapuram and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

6.The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
