PRAYER: This petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C to direct the learned III Additional District and Sessions Judge / PCR Cases, Madurai District, to consider the bail application of the petitioner on the same day on merits in the event of their surrender in connection with Crime No.166 of 2016, on the file of the respondent.

O R D E R

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have come forward with this petition seeking for a direction to the learned III Additional District and Sessions Judge / PCR Cases, Madurai District, to consider the bail application of the petitioners on the same day on their surrender in Crime No.166 of 2016, pending on the file of the respondent Police.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners has also submitted that the petitioners have been implicated in this case for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 323, 324 I.P.C., r/w Section 3 (2)(va) of SC/ST Amendment Act, 2015, and that in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the said Act, the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail application and therefore, the petitioners have come forward with the said prayer.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) takes notice for the respondent.

4. Considering the submissions of both sides and also considering the nature of the prayer in this case, in view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the S.C. & S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, that the petitioners cannot move any anticipatory bail, the learned III Additional District and Sessions Judge / PCR Cases, Madurai District, is



directed to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider their bail application, in the event of the petitioners filing such petition in Crime No.166 of 2016, on the file of the respondent Police, and dispose of the same on merits and in accordance with law on the same day.

5. With the above observation, this criminal original petition is disposed of.
