PRAYER: Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. praying to direct the learned Juvenile Justice Board, Madurai to consider the bail application filed by the petitioner /Accused on the same day in Crime No.219 of 2016 on the file of the responden police and to accept their surrender on the same day on merits.

ORDER

It is an application seeking a direction to the learned Juvenile Justice Board, Madurai to consider the bail application of the the petitioner on the same day of his surrender in Crime No.219 of 2016.

2.Heard the learned Government Advocate (Cr1.side) for the respondents. There is no representation for the petitioner.

3.A case in Crime No.219 of 2016 has been registered against the petitioner along with others in respect of the offences under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 324, 506(ii) and 392 IPC r/w 3 (1)(r), 3(1)(s) of SC/ST Act. The allegation against the petitioner is that on 18.02.2016 at about 02.00 pm. there is a dispute between two communities and at the time when the defacto complainant came there, the accused Nos.1, 2 and 8, abused his caste name and caused injury on his head.



4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would submit that accused Nos.1 to 3 are in custody in connection with Crime No.219 of 2016 and investigation is almost completed.

5.A perusal of FIR would show that there are only two named persons as accused viz., Mondu S/o.Muthaiah Servai and Palani. The allegation in the FIR is against the said Mondu and rest of them are stated to have assaulted the defacto complainant only by using hands.

6.Under such circumstances, the Juvenile Justice Board, Madurai is directed to consider the bail application of the petitioner and pass orders on merits on the same day of his appearance.

7.With the above direction, this petition is disposed of.
