ORDER

This petition has been filed for a direction to the second respondent to register a case on the basis of the petitioner's complaint dated 28.03.2016.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondents.

3. The sum and substance of the complaint preferred by the petitioner is that on believing the words of the accused person that he will give his property to lease, the petitioner had given a sum of Rs.5,40,000/- on various occasions. However, neither the land has been handed over nor he returned the said said amount. Therefore, a complaint came to be lodged by the petitioner herein. Since no action has been taken on the said complaint, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. According to the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), petition enquiry is stated to be pending before the 2nd respondent.



5. In view of the above submission, the respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and complete the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent police shall take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]. In case of closure of the complaint, a copy of the closure report be furnished to the petitioner within a week of such closure. On receipt of the same, it is open to the petitioner to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.

With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
