Hence, the petitioner has come up with this petition for the aforesaid prayer.



4.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), on instructions, would submit that the respondent requires four months time to complete the investigation and to file a final report in Crime No.695 of 2013.

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5.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent to complete the investigation and file a final report before the Court concerned within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
