Prayer:- Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to direct the second respondent herein to register an FIR on the basis of the petitioner's complaint dated 18.03.2016 which had been acknowledged in CSR.No.88 of 2016 by the second respondent.

ORDER

It is an application seeking a direction to the second respondent to register a case based on the complaint of the petitioner dated 18.03.2016.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondents.

3.The sum and substance of the complaint of the petitioner is that on 12.03.2016, while the petitioner proceeded to graze his goats in a street, the proposed accused questioned him as to why he was proceeding through their street. They also abused the petitioner with filthy language and caused cut injury



on his right side head. As there was no case registered, the petitioner has come up with this petition.

4. According to the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), petition enquiry is pending.

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5. In view of the above submission, the second respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and complete the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the second respondent police shall take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]**. In case of closure of the complaint, a copy of the closure report be furnished to the petitioner within a week of such closure. On receipt of the same, it is open to the petitioner to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.

6. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
