ORDER

It is an application seeking a direction to the second respondent to register a case based on the complaint of the petitioner dated 02.05.2016.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondents.

3.The sum and substance of the complaint of the petitioner is that the petitioner is working as a driver in the Transport Corporation, Kumbakonam Division. While the petitioner was working in Thiruppathur Depot, he was refused to report duty by the Depot Manager, Thirupathur, without any reason. He was also given so many vexatious Memos by the said Depot Manager. Later on, he came to know that only due to his caste, he was not allowed to join. As there was no case registered, the petitioner has come up with this petition.



4. According to the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), petition enquiry is pending.

5. In view of the above submission, the first respondent is directed to ask the concerned jurisdictional Investigating Officer to expedite the enquiry and complete the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the concerned jurisdictional Investigating Officer shall take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]**. In case of closure of the complaint, a copy of the closure report be furnished to the petitioner within a week of such closure. On receipt of the same, it is open to the petitioner to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.

6. With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
