Petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure to direct the 2nd respondent police to register the FIR based on the petitioner's complaint dated 31.03.2016 and investigate the same in accordance with law.

ORDER

This petition has been filed for a direction to the 2nd respondent police to register the FIR based on the petitioner's complaint dated 31.03.2016 and investigate the same in accordance with law.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondents.

3. On false promise to get medical seats for the sons of the petitioner's friends, a sum of Rs.27 lakhs was paid to one P.V.Ravichandran and Muthukumar, through the petitioner. However, they neither got the seats nor returned the said money to the petitioner's friends. Therefore, the petitioner's friends, namely, Jawaharlal Nehru and Muthukumar demanded the said money from the petitioner herein and they along with other persons are stated to have tortured the petitioner, as the petitioner acted as a Mediator. Since, no action has been taken on the complaint



preferred by the petitioner, the petitioner is before this Court with this petition.

4. According to the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), petition enquiry is pending before the 2nd respondent.

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5. In view of the above submission, the respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and complete the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent police shall take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]**. In case of closure of the complaint, a copy of the closure report be furnished to the petitioner within a week of such closure. On receipt of the same, it is open to the petitioner to work out his remedy in the manner known to law.

With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
