ORDER

This petition has been filed for a direction to the 2nd respondent police to register a case based on the petitioner's complaint dated 04.04.2016.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondents.

3. The sum and substance of the complaint preferred by the petitioner is that her brothers in connivance of the Village Administrative Officer and others, by forging the signature of the petitioner, sold the properties belong to their father without the knowledge of the petitioner. Therefore, she gave a complaint against the accused persons. Since no action has been taken, the present petition has been filed.

4. According to the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), petition enquiry is pending before the 3rd respondent.



5. In view of the above submission, the 3rd respondent is directed to expedite the enquiry and complete the same within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. During the course of enquiry, if any cognizable offence is made out, the respondent police shall take action in accordance with the law laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Lalitha Kumari vs. Govt. of U.P & others [2013 (4) Crimes 243 (SC)]. In case of closure of the complaint, a copy of the closure report be furnished to the petitioner within a week of such closure. On receipt of the same, it is open to the petitioner to work out her remedy in the manner known to law.

With the above direction, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
