PRAYER: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of quo-warranto, directing the respondents 4 to 6 and other similarly placed persons, who got their appointments from the waiting list of Group-I services 2000-2001 batch, conducted by Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission to show cause under what authority they are holding the public post in pursuant to the judgment of this Hon'ble Court dated 04.03.2011 passed in W.A.Nos.1063 and 1287 of 2009 in which 83 candidates selections were set aside and later, which was confirmed and upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India by its judgment dated 30.06.2014 delivered in C.A.No.5877-78/2014 and to prevent them in



continuing in the offices and consequently to declare those offices to be vacant in the interest of justice.
