ORDER

The father-in-law of the detainee filed this Habeas Corpus Petition to trace out the detainee and produce her before this Court along with her minor son by name Senbagaraj, aged about seven years.

2. The parties appeared before us. In view of the submission made by the learned Counsel for the parties, we referred the matter to the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Madurai. The Report submitted by the Tamil Nadu Mediation and Conciliation Centre, dated 26.08.2016 indicates that the mediation failed.



3. The matter was taken up for consideration today. We have examined the detinue and her son. The detinue informed us that she is not willing to go with the petitioner. She wanted to go to Thiruppur along with his minor son by name Shenbagarj.

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4. The detinue is a major. She is set at liberty. It is open to the parties to move the concerned Family Court for appropriate relief.

5. The Habeas Corpus Petition is disposed of with the above observation.
