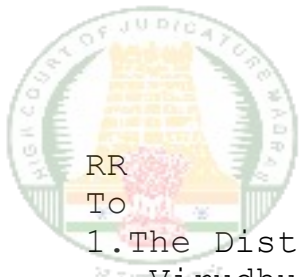
The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the Habeas Corpus petition. He has also made an endorsement to that effect.
