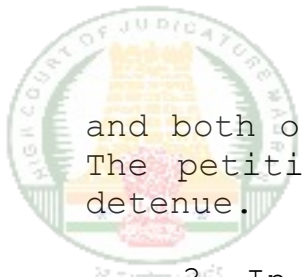

ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by **S.NAGAMUTHU, J.**)

The petitioner, who is the father of one Priyanka, aged 23 years, has come up with this Habeas Corpus Petition, alleging that his daughter has been found missing from 03.10.2016 onwards. In this regard, a case has also been registered in Crime No.134 of 2016 on 12.10.2016 for woman missing. Since the detainee was not rescued by the police, the petitioner has come up with the present Habeas Corpus Petition.

2. Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the detainee along with the third respondent had consumed poison at Coimbatore



and both of them are taking treatment in a Hospital at Coimbatore. The petitioner is also now staying with them taking care of the detainee.

3. In view of the same, nothing survives in this Habeas Corpus Petition. The Habeas Corpus Petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
