Challenging the order of the second respondent, dated 25.10.2016, in C.M.P.No.03/2016[CS], the father of the detenu - T.Ramkumar, aged 31 years, S/o.Thanuskodi, who is under detention, has come up with this Habeas Corpus Petition.



2. Today, when the Habeas Corpus Petition was taken up for consideration, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor produced a copy of the order in G.O.Rt.No.436, Co-Operation, Food and Consumer Protection (E3), Department, dated 18.11.2016, revoking the order of detention by the Advisory Board.

3. In view of the order dated 18.11.2016, nothing survives for adjudication in the Habeas Corpus Petition. Hence, the Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed as infructuous.
