In HCP (MD) No.665/2016, one Gunavathy, has filed the petition stating that her son Neelakandan aged 34 years, was arrested by the respondent police on the same day. The petitioners have stated that several cases are registered against their sons.

3. The respondents also filed a common status report in both the petitions stating that both the detenus/accused were involved in 19 cases and they were also stated in Paragraph No.6 of the status report about the cases pending against the said two detenus.

4. Recording the said status report, the submission of the respondents, these petitions were closed, by directing the petitioners to work out their remedy before the Court concerned.
