2.The detainee by name Amutha is the wife of the petitioner. She informed us that on account of certain misunderstanding and violence inflicted on her by the petitioner, she left the matrimonial home and is residing elsewhere.



4. We have examined the petitioner also.

5. The detinue is a major. She is set at liberty. The child is presently staying with the detinue. It is open to the petitioner to workout his remedy in the manner known to law.

6. The habeas corpus petition is closed with the above observation.
