4.In view of the limited scope of the prayer, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the issue involved, the respondents are directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 25.02.2014, and pass appropriate orders on the same and in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after affording the petitioner an opportunity of being heard. If on a specified date the petitioner does not appear for personal hearing, orders may be passed in accordance with law based on the available records after recording the absence of the Party/Parties.

5.With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
