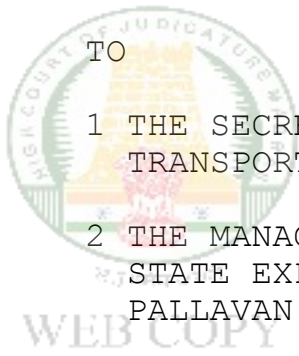
Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner. None appears on behalf of the second and third respondents.
