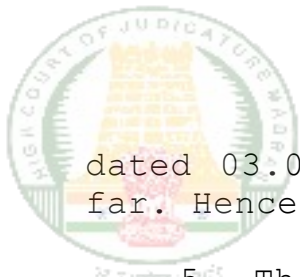
O R D E R

5. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondent would submit that considering the law and problem prevalent in the area, the permission for conducting programme will be considered.

6. Under such circumstances, the respondent police is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 03.06.2016 and pass orders on merits and as per law forthwith.

With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
