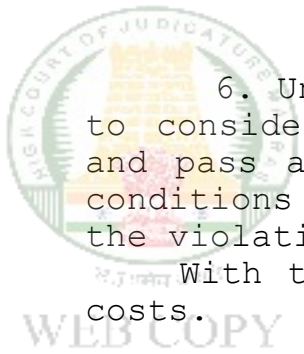
O R D E R

With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
