ORDER

However, we direct the Principal District Judge to consider the representation on its merits in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. The Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly. No Costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
