PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant the petitioner 4th and 5th review benefits and to revise his pay in the Post of Checking Inspector with retrospective effect from 24.02.2014 in terms of Government Order in G.O.Ms.No.61, Transport(C) Department, dated 30.04.2015 and as per settlement dated 22.01.2011 and further directing the respondents to pay him the difference amount in his salary and to pay difference in his retirement benefits including difference amount in monthly pension, gratuity, leave salary, commuted value of pension and all other attendant benefits payable to him from 01.05.2014 to till date together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum.
