Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay all the terminal benefits payable to the petitioner including salary arrears in terms of settlement from 01.09.2013 to 31.07.2014, Provident Fund, Social Security Scheme Amount, Refund of Institute of Road Transport Contribution amount, Earned Leave Salary, Medical leave salary, in terms of the settlement under Section 12(3) of the Industrial Disputes Act, dated 13.04.2015 together with interest at the rate of 18% per annum from the date of his retirement to till the date of payment within the time that may be stipulated by this Court.
