4.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the car festival is being conducted by the Devasthanam regularly in order to promote harmony during the above said festival period; that a representation was given to the 4th respondent, but, however, the same was not considered by the 4th respondent so far and hence, the petitioner is before this Court with this writ petition. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would further submit that as the aforesaid festival is celebrated in a peaceful manner by the Devasthanam, there will be no untoward incident on account of this celebration.

5.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, on instructions, would submit that the respondents may be directed to consider the representation of the petitioner.

6.In view of the submission made by the learned Additional Government Pleader, the Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the 4th respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 27.07.2016 as expeditiously as possible, as the festival is scheduled to be conducted on 05.08.2016. No costs.
