O R D E R

This Writ Petition has been filed by C.Guruvaiah under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking to quash the proceedings of the 7th respondent dated 04.07.2016.

2.In view of the ratio laid down by the larger bench judgment of this Court in (K.Marappan Vs. The Deputy Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Namakkal Circle, Namakkal-636 001 and another) reported in (2006 (4) CTC 689) this Court is not inclined to entertain the Writ Petition. Accordingly, this Writ Petition is dismissed.

3.It is not known why the petitioner has filed this writ petition when he has a better, statutory, alternative Appeal remedy under Section 152 of the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Societies Act. Hence, it is open to the petitioner to workout his remedy in the manner known to law. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are also dismissed.
