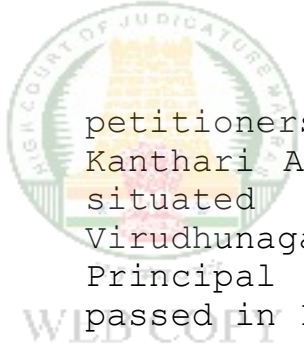

5. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed. No Costs.
