2. By consent, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal during the time of admission.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Special Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the respondents.

The petitioner submitted a representation to the first respondent complaining that the third and fourth respondents are collecting huge amount by way of grant showing large number of students, notwithstanding the fact that there are only two students, who are enjoying the benefits provided by the Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar Welfare Department. In short, it is the grievance of the petitioner that the third and fourth respondents have been collecting huge amount under the pretext that there are large number of students residing in the hostel.

5. The representation was submitted only on 01.07.2016. Even before the expiry of one month, the petitioner has come up with this Writ Petition.

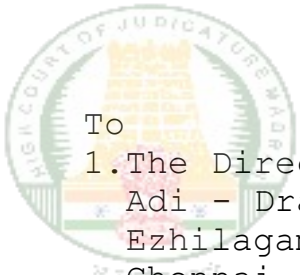
6. The representation is now pending on the file of the first respondent.
