4.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the Respondents.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, the third respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 25.07.2016 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
